Bunnie Walker is the chair of the pastor search committee that recommended Lee Canipe to be the fifth senior pastor of Providence Baptist Church.

Bill Wilson is the founding director of the Center for Healthy Churches, a ministry devoted to improving the spiritual and emotional well-being of congregations and their leaders. He was instrumental in working with the committee to establish initial congregational listening sessions and in advising the committee on various procedures for developing the church and pastor profiles.

Jack Causey is the recently-retired Ministerial Resources Coordinator for the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship of North Carolina. Jack worked as an advisor and mentor to the chair, Bunnie Walker. He also met with the committee on several occasions to offer guidance on search procedures and resume reviews. Jack brought a number of candidates to the committee's attention. One of these candidates was Dr. Canipe.

Bill Leathers is the grandfather of Helen, Watt, and Peter Canipe. He served as pastor of Baptist churches in Georgia and North Carolina, before retiring in 2009 from First Baptist Church of Hickory.

Larry Hovis is the executive coordinator for the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship of North Carolina. He served the pastor search committee by sharing his insights on various questions the committee presented. He also provided professional recommendations that proved helpful to the committee.

Bo Prosser is coordinator of organizational relationships for the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship. He is also a former associate pastor of Providence Baptist Church. Bo's experience at Providence allowed him to offer the committee a unique perspective during the search process. His insight and guidance were valuable assets, especially in helping the committee sort through resumes and narrow its focus.
